With found cartoons, comic book imagery and abstract elements dissonantly layered over pornographic photographs from the 1590's and 60's, Ms. Workman's large inkjet prints, laminated to sheets of transparent plastic, are curiously reminiscent of David Salle's early paintings. In contrast to his misogynistic gloom, however, her works offer an insouciantly feminist take on sex and powers.

Laminated to the reverse side of Plexiglass panels that are attached to the wall by heavy bolts, Ms. Workman's layered, digitalized montages of found imagery – little girls, scientific or technical diagrams, girly cartoons and old smut photographs – meditate on innocence, experience, consumerism and modernity.
